## **EAA Chapter 42**

# Board of Directors Meeting Minutes November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022

Lars called the meeting to order at 7:41 P.M.

- Scott distributed minutes from the last board meeting in October and agenda for the November meeting
- Board reviewed and approved the October minutes.

### Ed gave the Treasurers report:

- Ed proposed moving \$10K from the Chapter's checking account into CD's paying approximately 3.5% per year. Ed plans to stagger deposits at \$5K per CD, so CD's mature every 6 months making funds available as needed. Board unanimously approved this resolution.
- Ed collected officer signatures on FNBA account documents. This adds Scott and Lars as signers on the Chapter 42 account.
- Ed opened a Young Aviators account at FNBA. Collected signatures of Scott and Lars as signers on this new account.
- Board reviewed and approved the Treasurers report.
- Ed will complete the EAA Annual Charter Renewal upon receipt of the link & passcode from EAA in November.
- Ed discussed the \$178 Young Eagles credit which is available to the club until December 31<sup>st</sup>,
   2022.
  - Jim Moss and Scott McEwen agreed to research options including books, hats, t shirts, and other items which could be purchased and distributed at future Young Eagle events.
     A decision is to be made before the November chapter meeting to allow for time to order items before years end.
  - The board agreed the purchase of a laptop or printer is not needed at this time.

#### Lars gave the Government Affairs report:

- Discussed developments in unleaded aviation fuel.
- Discussed upcoming DOT meeting on airport improvements at Birchwood schedule for 10AM on November 12<sup>th</sup> at Civil Air Patrol Hanger.

Discussed ideas for upcoming Chapter meetings.

- Lars to do a presentation on his recent flight from the lower 48 to Alaska in his Volmer VJ-22 Sportsman experimental aircraft at the November chapter meeting. Meeting will be held at the Alaska Airmen's conference room on Lake Hood.
- We will not hold a December Chapter meeting.
- Chuck volunteered to host a January (or future) meeting at the Alaska Aviation Museum. The museum is in the process of restoring an Noorduyn Norseman bush plane.
- Dave Swartz (Continuous Operations Safety Advisor, FAA) may be an option for a future meeting. Scott said Dave is willing to discuss the ongoing development of unleaded aviation fuels.
- Chris shared a draft email asking members for ideas for future meetings. The board reviewed
  the email, gave a few good suggestions, and approved sending of the email to the members
  email distribution list.
