

## **EAA Chapter 42 Tool Club Inventory Access Policy**

EAA Chapter 42 maintains items available to chapter members for Chapter associated activities or other approved uses. The chapter inventory contains an assortment of tools and items useful to chapter members.

Chapter tools and items will be maintained and stored in a manner to prevent loss or theft as directed by the board.

Chapter tools and inventory items are accessible for use by all “Active” Chapter Members. “Active” Chapter member means an individual who has paid the current calendar year chapter dues and is a current or life member with National EAA.

Members may request use of the tools or inventory items through a board member or the designated “Caretaker”.

Members will exercise proper care to ensure tools and inventory items are not damaged. Members will be responsible for replacement or repair for damage due to negligence or misuse. Members will return the items to the designated caregiver within two (2) weeks of borrowing the items or at the agreed upon time.

Inventory items are available to members to use free of charge based upon availability and first request.

The aircraft scales are available to members free of charge. The Chapter provides the scales for use and does not guarantee the accuracy of the scales. AC 43.13 and AC 120-27E paragraph 104 discusses calibration or certification advisory information. Members are encouraged to verify the accuracy of the scales at each time of use to ensure that measurements are correct. This should be done in accordance with the manufacturer recommendations. If a member chooses to have the scales calibrated/certified the member is responsible for the cost of the calibration/certification.
